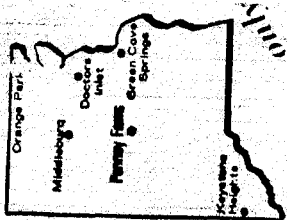

Services Set For Mrs. Theresa Marie



Funeral services for Mrs. Theresa Redmond Marie, will be held at 1 p.m. Saturday in the First African Baptist Church, Green Cove Springs. Mrs. Marie died Sunday night in Clay Memorial Hospital after an illness.

Mrs. Marie was a native of Green Cove Springs and attended Elementary school in Green Cove and went to high school at Palmer Memorial in Sedalia, N.C. She received her college training at Florida Normal and Industrial College in St. Augustine and her B.S. degree from Tuskegee Institute, Tuskegee, Alabama. She received her master's degree from Florida A. & M. University, Tallahassee. She taught 17 years at Dunbar High School and served one year as its principal. She also taught at Clay High School and had a total of

42 years of teaching in the public schools. At the time of her retirement in 1979 she was guidance counselor at Clay High School. She was a member of First African Baptist Church.

On Nov. 14, 1954 the auditorium at Dunbar High School was named the T.R. Marie Auditorium in her honor. After the city purchased the school it was changed, but a re-dedication ceremony took place Feb. 13, 1982 restoring the auditorium to its original name, "The T.R. Marie Auditorium."

Mrs. Marie was a civic minded resident of Green Cove Springs serving on many committees and was a member of the Green Cove Springs Planning and Zoning Board.

Survivors include: daughters and son-in-law, Barbara Marie Holland (Sherman); Joanne Marie, brother and sister-in-law, Christopher Redmond (Deloris), Clarence Herring; two aunts, Nellie Redmond and Margaret Frazier; two nieces, Jacqueline and Bernadette; four nephews, Charles, William, Kenneth and Louis Redmond; a host of cousins including Josephine, Grace and Thedasia, and other sorrowing friends.
